CONTEXT



Colombia

Since 2018, the National Government requested support and technical cooperation from the United Nations System in Colombia, in order to join efforts to address the emergency arising from the mixed migratory flow of Venezuelan population. UNICEF has focused its support on an Annual Response Plan (HAC)

Furthemore, the current challenges posed by multi-affecting emergencies (armed conflict and natural disasters) demonstrate the need for a comprehensive HAC that responds to the specific needs of the territory. In the development and implementation of this plan, UNICEF has identified the need to consolidate, utilize, and analyze information to plan and report on actions, as well as to strengthen coordination mechanisms at both national and territorial levels, and transfer methodologies and tools to the involved stakeholders.

In this regard, 3iSolution has been assisting the country office in strengthening its information management processes, resulting in more timely and high-quality information products for its response plan. This collaboration has also helped prioritize key issues related to the situation of children and adolescents at both national and territorial levels and optimize processes for reporting on UNICEF's humanitarian response and its implementing partners.


